# 1	(-1) Why two antibiotics? An infection may be caused by multiple organisms and broad coverage is good if the causative agent is unknown (-1) Why IV therapy? Faster response; optimal in emergency or infection
#2	(-1) Why change antibiotic? Resistant/ not effective (-1) What agents? Mention vancomycin or linezolid or Synercid®
#3	(-1) Why is aspirin not optimal? Aspirin primarily for inflammation, OA less inflammation. Generally, not first line therapy and the dose not appropriate for inflammation (-1) What to recommend (include dose)? Acetaminophen (1000mg, 4 times/day) is first line agent. COX2 inhibitor OK
#4	(-1) RA/OA Similar: slow or reverse disease progression (-1) RA/OA Differ: RA more inflammation, therefore agents target inflammation. Different first line agents recommended
#5	(-1) What JNC VII classification? Normal to pre-hypertensive (-1) Why are two readings insufficient? Additional readings for clarification. 3 readings above normal over 2-3 weeks required (see text) because BP may vary day-to-day, hour-to-hour.
